Why is Pluto no longer a planet?

**Profile**  
Researchers claim that a huge planet almost the size of Neptune probably exists in the frozen Kuiper Belt region of our solar system. It has not yet been located or photographed.

**Criteria**  
- It is in orbit around the Sun.  
- It has sufficient mass to assume hydrostatic equilibrium (a nearly round shape).  
- It has "cleared the neighborhood" around its orbit.

## Space Rocks:

**Comet**  
A ball of ice and rock originating from the outer Solar System, often surrounded by a coma and tail.

**Asteroid**  
A rocky body generally between Mars and Jupiter. Comets are icy and originate from the outer Solar System.

**Meteoroid**  
A small body that is larger than a dust grain but smaller than an asteroid. If it strikes Earth it is a meteorite.

**Meteor**  
A streak of light seen when a meteoroid passes through Earth's atmosphere.

**Meteorite**  
A meteor that survives to reach the ground. It is a rock from space.
